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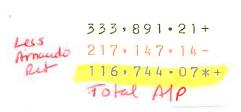

#### AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THAT APPLICATION BE MADE TO OBTAIN A GRANT UNDER THE UNITED STATES BUREAU OF RECLAMATION WATERSMART DROUGHT RESPONSE GRANT PROGRAM AND AUTHORIZATION TO PROVIDE ASSURANCES AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT RELATED TO THE GRANT FOR THE SOUTH SYSTEM IMPROVEMENT PROJECT (PHASE 4)

WHEREAS, The Bureau of Reclamation released its Funding Opportunity No. R25AS00013 soliciting applications for the WaterSMART Drought Response Program: Drought Resiliency Projects for Fiscal Year 2025; and

WHEREAS, the North San Joaquin Water Conservation District (District) South System Improvement Project- Phase 4 (Project) is an eligible project under the funding opportunity; and

WHEREAS, the Project involves replacing and enlarging capacity limited sections of the existing South System distribution system by installing approximately 9,000 Linear Feet (LF) of 48" Rubber Gasketed Reinforced Concrete Pipe (RGRCP) and 8,400 LF of 60 RGRCP, three automated distribution boxes, meters and SCADA facilities, to increase the capacity of the South System to accommodate the maximum flow rate of the South System Pump Station and allow for maximum irrigation and groundwater recharge surface water deliveries under the District's Mokelumne River water right.

WHEREAS, the Project is part of a multi-phase project evaluated by the District under the California Environmental Quality Act in the August 16, 2016 Initial study and Mitigated Negative Declaration, for which the District issued a Notice of Determination on August 29, 2016, filed in San Joaquin County on September 1, 2016, Document No. 39-09012016-285; and

WHEREAS, if the grant is awarded and the project proceeds, the District would conduct an Environmental Assessment and such other studies as are required to assist the Bureau of Reclamation to comply with the National Environmental Policy Act with respect to the Project;

WHEREAS, the Project is an important part of the Eastern San Joaquin Subbasin Groundwater Sustainability Plan and the District's Strategic Plan, approved in December 2021 after public workshops and feedback, to improve the District's facilities, including the South System, for in-lieu and direct groundwater recharge purposes so that the District can fully utilize its surface water rights, alleviate groundwater overdraft conditions and achieve groundwater sustainability such that the District can remain resilient during periods of drought.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the North San Joaquin Water Conservation District (District), as follows:

- 1. District staff are directed to prepare and submit an application to the United States Bureau of Reclamation WaterSMART Drought Response Grant Program for the South System Improvement Project (Phase 4), and enter into an agreement with the Bureau to complete the Project in accordance with the Bureau grant guidelines, if awarded; and
- 2. The District President is authorized to execute the application, assurances and agreements required by the Bureau to secure the grant.
- 3. District staff are directed to take all action necessary to carry out the purposes of this Resolution.

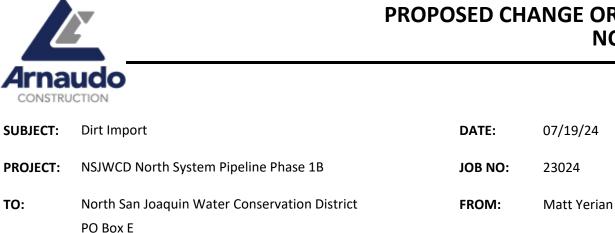

#### 1<sup>st</sup> AMENDMENT TO GROUND LEASE for GROUNDWATER RECHARGE PROJECT (Lakso Property, APN 017-240-080, APNs 017-240-009 and 017-220-001)

This 1st Amendment to the Lease Agreement ("Lease") is effective August 1, 2024, by and between John Lakso and Helen Lakso, Trustees (collectively "Lessor") and North San Joaquin Water Conservation District ("District").

- Existing Lease. The parties entered a GROUND LEASE for GROUNDWATER RECHARGE PROJECT effective September 1, 2023 that enables District to conduct recharge activities on the property known as APN 017-240-080 between harvest and April 1<sup>st</sup> in exchange for a payment of \$4,000 per year.
- 2. <u>Purpose of Amendment.</u> Lessor has removed the vineyard on APN 017-240-080 and on most of the adjacent parcels known as APNs 017-240-009 and 017-220-001. The parties desire to agree on terms under which District may conduct recharge on all three of these parcels for the remainder of 2024.
- 3. <u>Additional Rent for Additional Acres and Months of Recharge</u>. In addition to the \$4,000 per year payable to Lessor by District under the Lease, District shall pay Lessor \$20 per acre per month for:
  - a. Recharge conducted on APN 017-240-080 acres outside of the November 1, 2023 to April 1, 2024 time period.
  - b. Recharge conducted on APNs 017-240-009 and 017-220-001 acres during any month.
  - c. The parties will meet and confer to agree on the number of acres used for recharge during the Term.
- 4. <u>Term</u>. This Amendment shall remain in effect until at least February 1, 2025. Thereafter, either party may terminate the Amendment on two-weeks notice.
- 5. <u>Effect of Amendment</u>. Additional recharge pursuant to this First Amendment shall be subject to all of the other terms and conditions of the Lease other than as expressly set forth herein, in which the terms of this First Amendment shall control. All terms of the Lease shall remain in full force and effect except as modified herein.

The following summarizes the status of current projects, upcoming work to be completed, and the anticipated schedules and project milestones.

#### South System

Operation of the South System has been ongoing, diverting approximately 10 CFS up until last week where flows were reduced to about 6 CFS for recharge at the Tecklenburg basin and irrigation deliveries along the south system. There continues to be a few spots with seepage that will need to be monitored as we approach harvest season. Fish screen operation has continued successfully with minimal sand buildup.

Construction of the South System Phase II project is nearing completion. Actuators and the remaining Sierra Controls equipment was installed and tested last week.

Submittals for the additional south pump have been submitted and the pump is on order. Expected delivery date from the manufacturer is October. The VFD submittal was received last week. Delivery of the VFD is expected to be 4-6 months from date of submittal approval.

# Handel Lateral

The Handle Lateral 60% plans are complete and discussions with landowners are ongoing.

# **Eastside Ditch**

The east side ditch has been operational and is being used regularly to deliver irrigation water as needed.

The survey documentation of the East Ditch is complete and under review. Staff is working to schedule meeting to discuss next steps for this project.

#### **DREAM Project and Pixley Pipeline**

The Pixley pump has been operational for irrigation. The VFD has been having issues with the power and or the heat and is being evaluated by the supplier.

# **Tecklenburg Recharge Basin**

Operation of the project has been ongoing since February and will likely continue throughout the summer as flows are available or until the project is ready for construction of Phase III. The existing mainline is unable to handle additional head and the existing private lateral is too small to take advantage of the full site. As such, only approximately 4 acres is currently being flooded of the 10 acre site.

We are working to prepare a bid package for the new 24" mainline and valves and automation at the basin.

#### **Tracy Lakes Improvement District**

Tracy lake operation has been ongoing as need to maintain the lake levels for irrigation.

#### North System

The Reynolds and Lakso recharge projects are currently shut down as we await PG&E to hook up power. The PG&E installation is planned for September 16<sup>th</sup>.

Installation of the Phase 1B 42" line is complete. Once landowners are ready to hook up for recharge, we will test and flush the line in preparation for operation.

Staff is evaluating options to get landowners connected to the new system for irrigation deliveries once the pipeline construction is complete as well as an option to extend the pipeline to connect additional land for recharge.

# North System Pump

Conceptual plans have been completed and we will be coordinating this week with District staff and consultants to review and develop a submittal strategy for permitting and agency review.

# Cal-Fed Pump

The Costa field recharge project has been shut down for the growing season.

Staff is working to get proposals for upgrading the pump station including installation of new discharge piping and appurtenances, installation of additional catwalk area, and installation of a variable Frequency Drive.

#### **Monitoring Wells**

Staff is working with landowners to acquire easements for the remaining two wells and hopes to have them soon. Upon obtaining the additional easements, staff will release the contractor to begin installation.

#### BACKGROUND:

Consero Solutions provides monthly reports on funding opportunities for which the District has applied or for which the District is considering applying.

#### **DISCUSSION:**

 U.S. Bureau of Reclamation WaterSMART Drought Response Program Project Name: South System Modernization Project, Phase 4 Amount Requested: \$3 million (compared to \$5 million in FY 2024) Amount of Cost Share: 50% Application Due: October 7, 2025

**Status:** On July 24, 2024, the Bureau released the NOFO for the FY 2025 funding round. The Bureau has lowered the award limit to \$3,000,000 in FY 2025 compared to \$5,000,000 in FY 2024 and will fund less projects in total (20-40 in FY 2025 compared to 40-50 in FY 2024). The Board approved the District's intent to apply for the South System Modernization Project, Phase 4 at the July 29, 2024 Board meeting. The General Manager is working with Consero Solutions to complete the FY 2025 grant application by the October 7, 2024 due date.

**Context:** The WaterSMART Drought Response Program is an annual program which receives money through the annual federal appropriations process, but in the last couple of years also received an infusion of funding from the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law. The program typically limits applications to \$2 million and only provides between \$30 million and \$40 million in awards. The District applied unsuccessfully for a \$5 million grant from the program 2023-24 cycle for the South System Modernization Project, Phase 4. District staff met with WaterSMART grant managers on May 30, 2024 to review the District's application. The Bureau pointed out the District could have scored better with a more detailed budget, unique support letters, a better description of the incentives the District provides for landowners to engage in recharge, and a better description of the economic consequences of water scarcity in the region.

Project Name: N/A Amount Requested: Up to \$200,000 per grower Amount of Cost Share: Encouraged, but not required Release Request for Grant Application: November 28, 2023 Application Due: **TBD 2025**  **Status:** The Governor signed 2024-25 State budget legislation on June 29, 2024. The 2024-25 State budget contains a total of \$40 million for SWEEP programs. The proposed 2024 climate action bond contains an additional \$40 million for SWEEP activities "to promote on farm water use efficiency with a focus on multiple-benefit projects that improve resilience to climate change and save water on California agricultural operations" (pg. 27). Funds in the bond are specifically aimed at "projects that provide meaningful and direct benefits to socially disadvantaged farmers and ranchers" (pg. 27). Consero is reaching out to CDFA staff to determine the timing of the next funding round, as CDFA has not yet announced the date of future solicitations.

**Context:** The Department released the SWEEP Direct-to-Producer Grant Program guidelines and request for applications on November 28, 2023 and then postponed the solicitation in December 2023. On January 10, 2024, the Governor announced as part of his proposed 2024-25 State budget the delay of this grant program to 2025. District landowners may still apply for grants from the SWEEP Block Grant Pilot Program for the same purpose, which the District has rolled out with Stockton East this spring and for which some landowners have already applied. The Direct-to-Producer Grant Program is different from the SWEEP Block Grant Pilot Program in that it will award grants directly to growers. The Department has confirmed they will not exclude growers in the service areas of SWEEP Block Grant Pilot Program awardees like the District. At the March District Board meeting, the Board approved signing a letter from agricultural interests to support the inclusion of SWEEP funding in the climate action bond.

#### 3. Proposed 2024 Climate Action Bond

Status: On July 3, 2024, the Governor signed SB 867, the Safe Drinking Water, Wildfire Prevention, Drought Preparedness, and Clean Air Bond Act of 2024 (climate action bond), which will appear on the ballot on November 5, 2024 as California Proposition 4: the Parks, Environment, Energy, and Water Bond Measure. A copy of the bond with highlighted sections for funding of interest to the District is attached (Attachment A). Based on input from Consero's state lobbyist, the Energy and Environmental Consulting Group (EEC), recent polls indicate between 55% and 58% of registered voters are likely to vote for the bond (a majority vote is needed to pass). EEC recommends organizations which support the bond endorse Proposition 4 via a link from the Committee for Clean Water, Natural Resources and Parks. (Note: The Association of California Water Agencies and the Northern California Water Association declined to support the bond because they do not think there is sufficient funding in the bond for water-related projects.) The bond contains \$193 million for the California Department of Water Resources Sustainable Groundwater Management Program, \$100 million for integrated regional water management, \$40 million for the State Water and Energy Efficiency Program (SWEEP), and funding for other projects of interest to the District. Given State money may be less available in FY 2024-25 and future years due to the State's budget deficit, Consero recommends an aggressive effort to secure any remaining federal funds from the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act in 2024-25, as well as designing projects in 2024 and 2025 to prepare for the release of new State bond funding in 2025 and 2026.

**Context:** The District engaged in the climate action bond discussion because the State's budget deficit resulted in no significant funding in the proposed 2024-25 budget for grant programs of interest to the District, such as SGMA. As a result, Consero expects limited future funding rounds for these programs until voters approve the climate action bond or State grant programs funded by the Greenhouse Gas Reduction Fund provide funding for groundwater sustainability.

(4) Projects that implement countywide drought and water shortage contingency plans adopted pursuant to Chapter 10 (commencing with Section 10609.40) of Part 2.55 of Division 6 of the Water Code.

(5) Projects that prevent, reduce, or treat the contamination of groundwater that serves as a major source of drinking water for a community.

(6) Projects to consolidate water or wastewater systems or to extend wastewater service to residences currently served by inadequate onsite sewer treatment systems.

(7) Grants for projects and technical and financial assistance to address hexavalent chromium in drinking water.

(8) (A) Tribal water infrastructure projects that provide safe, clean, and reliable drinking water to tribal communities.

(B) Not less than twenty-five million dollars (\$25,000,000) shall be allocated to projects described in subparagraph (A).

(b) If there is a responsible party identified to have contributed to contamination of a drinking water well, or system, the water system or public agency responsible for the infrastructure may apply for competitive state grant program funding for a drinking water infrastructure project to address water quality issues. The grant applicant may apply for funding in the amount above and beyond what the responsible party is required to contribute to the infrastructure project.

(c) Reasonable geographic allocation to eligible projects throughout the state shall be considered, including both northern and southern California and inland and coastal regions.

(d) At least 40 percent of the allocation made pursuant to this section shall benefit disadvantaged communities, severely disadvantaged communities, or vulnerable populations.

(e) For severely disadvantaged communities with populations of no more than 500 persons that serve no more than 100 service connections, there shall be no maximum amount per service connection for eligible projects.

91012. (a) Of the funds made available by Section 91010, three hundred eighty-six million two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$386,250,000) shall be available, upon appropriation by the Legislature, to the Department of Water Resources for projects related to groundwater storage, groundwater banking, groundwater recharge, or instream flow projects that support the conjunctive use of groundwater and surface water supplies. Of the funds made available pursuant to this subdivision, a minimum of twenty-five million dollars (\$25,000,000) shall be for projects that provide direct benefits to tribal communities.

(b) Of the funds made available by subdivision (a), one hundred ninety-three million one hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$193,125,000) shall be available for projects that increase groundwater storage, improve the management and operation of groundwater storage, or are for groundwater banking, and support implementation of the Sustainable Groundwater Management Act (Part 2.74 (commencing with Section 10720) of Division 6 of the Water Code).

(2) This section does not preclude the water board from awarding funding to a large-scale water recycling or reuse project for multiple project phases or components, or more than once during the project development period. The water board shall not require user agreements or contracts for water delivery, nor shall full completion of the project be required before the submission of a subsequent grant application, as a condition for award of grant funding.

(3) At least 10 percent of the grant funding shall be awarded for the purpose of planning and design.

(4) Reasonable geographic allocation to eligible projects throughout the state, including both northern and southern California and coastal and inland regions.

91015. Of the funds made available by Section 91010, seventy-five million dollars (\$75,000,000) shall be available, upon appropriation by the Legislature, to the California Water Commission for projects under the Water Storage Investment Program. Priority for these funds and any funds returned to the commission shall be to support timely completion of existing approved projects by providing supplemental grants to reflect the increase in costs due to inflation since the original grant applications and any increase in public benefits.

91016. Of the funds made available by Section 91010, sixty-two million five hundred thousand dollars (\$62,500,000) shall be available, upon appropriation by the Legislature, for capital investments in brackish desalination, contaminant and salt removal, and salinity management projects to improve California water and drought resilience. Priority shall be given to projects that use new incremental eligible renewable energy resources during operation and reduce greenhouse gas emissions associated with their construction and operation.

91017. Of the funds made available by Section 91010, fifteen million dollars (\$15,000,000) shall be available, upon appropriation by the Legislature, to the Department of Water Resources and the State Water Resources Control Board to improve water data management and to implement Section 144 of the Water Code to reactivate existing stream gages and deploy new gages.

91018. Of the funds made available by Section 91010, seventy-five million dollars (\$75,000,000) shall be available, upon appropriation by the Legislature, to the Natural Resources Agency and the Department of Water Resources for competitive grants for regional conveyance projects or repairs to existing conveyances. Priority shall be given to projects that provide one or more of the following benefits:

(a) Improvements in regional or interregional water supply or water supply reliability.

(b) Increased groundwater recharge or mitigation of conditions of groundwater overdraft, salinity intrusion, water quality degradation, or subsidence.

(c) Adaptation to the impacts of hydrologic changes.

(d) Improvements in water security from drought, natural disasters, or other events that could interrupt water supplies.

(e) Providing safe drinking water for disadvantaged communities and economically distressed areas.

91019. Of the funds made available by Section 91010, seventy-five million dollars (\$75,000,000) shall be available, upon appropriation by the Legislature, to the Department of Water Resources for projects that increase water conservation in agricultural and urban areas.

91020. Of the funds made available by Section 91000, one billion one hundred forty million dollars (\$1,140,000,000) shall be available, upon appropriation by the Legislature, to reduce flood risk and improve stormwater management.

91021. Of the funds made available by Section 91020, five hundred fifty million dollars (\$550,000,000) shall be available, upon appropriation by the Legislature, to the Natural Resources Agency and its departments, boards, and conservancies for flood management projects. Priority shall be given to projects designed and implemented to achieve both flood safety and ecosystem functions, while providing additional benefits. At least 40 percent of the allocation made pursuant to this section shall benefit disadvantaged communities, severely disadvantaged communities, or vulnerable populations. Funding shall be allocated as follows:

(a) One hundred fifty million dollars (\$150,000,000) shall be available for projects in the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta to improve existing levees to increase flood protection and improve climate resiliency. For purposes of this subdivision, "Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta" has the same meaning as described in Section 12220 of the Water Code.

(b) One hundred fifty million dollars (\$150,000,000) shall be available for projects that implement the Flood Control Subventions Program.

(c) Two hundred fifty million dollars (\$250,000,000) shall be available for projects related to the systemwide evaluation, repair, rehabilitation, reconstruction, expansion, or replacement of levees, weirs, bypasses, and facilities of the State Plan of Flood Control.

91022. Of the funds made available by Section 91020, four hundred eighty million dollars (\$480,000,000) shall be available, upon appropriation by the Legislature, to the Department of Water Resources for the Dam Safety and Climate Resilience Local Assistance Program for competitive grants for projects that enhance dam safety and reservoir operations and protect public benefits pursuant to Section 6700 of the Water Code.

91023. Of the funds made available by Section 91020, one hundred ten million dollars (\$110,000,000) shall be available, upon appropriation by the Legislature, to the State Water Resources Control Board for grants for multiple-benefit urban stormwater management projects. Projects funded pursuant to this section shall address flooding in urbanized areas and provide multiple benefits, with preference given to natural infrastructure projects. Eligible stormwater projects shall include, but are not limited to, stormwater capture and reuse, planning and implementation of low-impact development,

restoration of urban streams and watersheds, debris flow mitigation, and increasing permeable surfaces to help reduce flooding.

91030. Of the funds made available by Section 91000, six hundred five million dollars (\$605,000,000) shall be available, upon appropriation by the Legislature, to protect and restore rivers, lakes, and streams, and to improve watershed resilience, including the resilience of fish and wildlife within the watershed.

91031. Of the funds made available by Section 91030, one hundred million dollars (\$100,000,000) shall be available, upon appropriation by the Legislature, to the Department of Water Resources for projects related to integrated regional water management to improve climate resilience on a watershed basis. The department shall update and revise the guidelines for the integrated regional water management program to address impacts associated with climate risk.

91032. Of the funds made available by Section 91030, three hundred thirty-five million dollars (\$335,000,000) shall be available, upon appropriation by the Legislature, for projects that protect and restore rivers, wetlands, streams, lakes, and watersheds, and improve the resilience of fish and wildlife. Projects shall improve climate resilience, water supplies, or water quality. To the extent feasible, preference shall be given to natural infrastructure projects. At least 40 percent of the allocation made pursuant to this section shall benefit disadvantaged communities, severely disadvantaged communities, or vulnerable populations. The funds made available pursuant to this section shall be allocated as follows:

(a) Forty million dollars (\$40,000,000) shall be available pursuant to Division 22.8 (commencing with Section 32600) for projects that improve the climate resiliency or the protection of the Los Angeles River Watershed or are consistent with the Lower Los Angeles River Revitalization Plan.

(b) Forty million dollars (\$40,000,000) shall be available pursuant to Division 23 (commencing with Section 33000) for projects that improve the climate resiliency or the protection of the Los Angeles River Watershed and are a part of the revitalization plan developed by the Upper Los Angeles River and Tributaries Working Group pursuant to Section 33220 or the Los Angeles River Master Plan.

(c) Fifty million dollars (\$50,000,000) shall be available to the Riverine Stewardship Program established pursuant to Section 7049 of the Water Code for projects that improve climate resiliency.

(d) Twenty-five million dollars (\$25,000,000) shall be available to the State Coastal Conservancy for the Santa Ana River Conservancy Program.

(e) Twenty-five million dollars (\$25,000,000) shall be available for multiple-benefit urban stream and river projects under the Urban Streams Restoration Program established pursuant to Section 7048 of the Water Code that protect and restore riparian habitats, improve climate resilience, enhance natural drainages, protect and restore watersheds, and provide public access.

(f) Twenty-five million dollars (\$25,000,000) shall be available to the Natural Resources Agency for projects that improve conditions on wildlife

Smart Strategy, California's 2022 Scoping Plan for Achieving Carbon Neutrality, and the California Climate Adaptation Strategy, if applicable.

#### Chapter 7. Climate Smart, Sustainable, and Resilient Farms, Ranches, and Working lands

93500. The sum of three hundred million dollars (\$300,000,000) shall be available, upon appropriation by the Legislature, for improving climate resilience and sustainability of agricultural lands.

93510. Of the funds made available by Section 93500, one hundred five million dollars (\$105,000,000) shall be available, upon appropriation by the Legislature, to the Department of Food and Agriculture's Office of Environmental Farming and Innovation for improvements in climate resilience of agricultural lands and ecosystem health and allocated to eligible projects as follows:

(a) Sixty-five million dollars (\$65,000,000) shall be available for grants to promote practices on farms and ranches that improve soil health, or accelerate atmospheric carbon removal or soil carbon sequestration.

(b) Forty million dollars (\$40,000,000) shall be available for the State Water Efficiency and Enhancement Program to promote onfarm water use efficiency with a focus on multiple-benefit projects that improve resilience to climate change and save water on California agricultural operations.

(c) Funds allocated pursuant to this section shall be allocated to projects that provide meaningful and direct benefits to socially disadvantaged farmers and ranchers.

93520. Of the funds made available by Section 93500, twenty million dollars (\$20,000,000) shall, upon appropriation by the Legislature, be deposited in the Invasive Species Account established pursuant to Section 7706 of the Food and Agricultural Code for purposes of funding invasive species projects and activities recommended by the Invasive Species Council of California. Preference shall be given to projects that restore and protect biodiversity and ecosystem health. Consideration shall be given to geographic equity.

93530. Of the funds made available by Section 93500, fifteen million dollars (\$15,000,000) shall be available, upon appropriation by the Legislature, to the Department of Conservation for projects for the protection, restoration, conservation, and enhancement of farmland and rangeland, including, but not limited to, the acquisition of fee title or easements, that improve climate resilience, open-space soil health, atmospheric carbon removal, soil carbon sequestration, erosion control, watershed health, water quality, or water retention. Projects shall provide multiple benefits. In awarding funds for farmland and rangeland projects pursuant to this section, the Department of Conservation shall give preference to projects for smalland medium-sized farms.

93540. Of the funds made available by Section 93500, ninety million dollars (\$90,000,000) shall be available, upon appropriation by the

DWR is asking that each amended GSP include a Demand Management Program that will be implemented and enforced if projects and management actions do not achieve sustainability. The following is the current proposal for this program to include in the GSP. Please review it. It will require that a program be implemented in NSJWCD by the end of 2028.

#### ESJ SUBBASIN DEMAND MANAGEMENT PROGRAM (Draft)

#### 1. Purpose:

DWR and the SWRCB are directing subbasins to include a "Demand Management Program" in their 5-year update GSPs. The reason is that surface water availability and the funding and actual completion of projects and management actions (PMAs) to use more surface water (inlieu of groundwater) are uncertain. The State wants to see that the GSAs in each subbasin have a plan to allocate and impose pumping restrictions if needed to prevent undesirable results in the event that groundwater levels continue to decline despite efforts to implement Project and Management Actions (PMAs).

# 2. How Much Less Groundwater Does the ESJ Subbasin Need to Use to Halt Groundwater Level Decline?

Before discussing "demand management" in the form of pumping restrictions, we must understand how much less groundwater we need to use subbasin wide to halt groundwater level decline. The current model indicates that the subbasin needs to pump 95,000 AFA less groundwater in order to halt negative changes in groundwater storage (without climate change). Given the inherent uncertainties with groundwater models and other factors (cropping patterns, hydrology, etc.), this will be our initial target for planning purposes.

Note that this number is about three times greater than the annual overdraft on a water balance basis because as less groundwater is pumped and groundwater levels recover, the model estimates that the subbasin will also receive less water from adjacent subbasins and from streams because of changes in groundwater level gradients.

Also note that this number assumes a Baseline condition of pumping that existed as of 2022 as determined by cropping patterns and urban pumping records. PMAs implemented going forward would be credited towards the 95,000 AFA target.

#### 3. How Can we Reduce Groundwater Use?

There are two general ways to accomplish 95,000 AFA less groundwater pumping:

- a. PMAs that either directly recharge groundwater or provide surface water to meet groundwater demand so that groundwater pumping is reduced without changing the land use or total water demand; or
- b. Reducing pumping through land fallowing or land repurposing that reduces the total demand for water.

To date, our subbasin GSP has focused on PMAs. The model currently assumes that the subbasin will implement the PMAs listed in the GSP, which will result in 33,000 AFA of demand reduction.

We will need to develop a further "Demand Reduction Program" to explain how we will make up the difference between the 33,000 AFA of demand reduction from these PMAs and the estimated 95,000 AFA of total demand reduction currently estimated to be necessary. The currently estimated difference we need to address is 56,000 AFA.

# 4. How Should the 56,000 AFA Additional Demand Reduction Goal be Allocated Among the GSAs?

Generally, the recommendation is that the responsibility for the 56,000 AFA should be allocated to each GSA on a pro-rata basis in direct relation to their contribution to the groundwater

overdraft. While this is a logical approach, the challenge is that imposing such an allocation requires that the GSAs agree on the allocation of the different components of the subbasin water budget to each GSA so that they can agree on each GSAs contribution to the overdraft and, therefore, their pro-rata allocation of demand management. There is currently disagreement on several of the allocations including the allocation of native yield (including natural channel seepage) and the allocation of GSA developed inflows (such as recharge from conveyance of water, recharge projects and irrigation return flows). The GSAs also need to agree on whether (and if so, how) to address the difference between municipal groundwater pumping rights and overlying rights in the allocation process. The GSAs need to commit to a time schedule and method to resolve these matters so that they can reach a written agreement on allocation. The recommendation is that any such agreement be subject to annual review and modification and not be a binding determination of rights, but rather a planning tool.

#### 5. How Should the Demand Reduction Program be Presented in the 2025 ESJ GSP Update?

It is recommended that we include the attached language regarding Demand Management in the GSP 5-year update.

The GSAs and GWA have committed to adopting a Demand Reduction Program (DR Program) by December 31, 2026. The Program will have the following elements:

• Stated goal of total demand reduction to achieve a modeled zero change in groundwater storage conditions and recovery to 2015 groundwater levels by 2040 implemented either by PMAs that directly recharge groundwater or provide surface water to meet groundwater demand so that pumping is reduced without changing the land use; or reducing pumping through land fallowing or land repurposing that reduces the total demand for water, or a combination of both.

• The DR Program will include strict timelines for phased implementation so that if deadlines for PMAs are not met, the GSA will implement reduced pumping requirements.

• Demand Management goal will be imposed upon individual GSAs on a pro-rata basis in relation to their contribution to the identified basin overdraft.

• Demand reduction goal will be updated annually (or every 5 years) based on model runs and updated data and assumptions.

• The GSAs will agree on an initial allocation of responsibility for reducing demand within their GSA areas by **December 31, 2026.** 

- The GSAs agree that this allocation of responsibility is not a determination of rights to pump or rights to specific types of groundwater, is not an admission by any party, and is for planning purposes only.
- At the same time this initial allocation agreement shall also include agreement on a process to track GSA water budgets consistently across the subbasin with actual data reported annually that is shared with all GSAs in the subbasin.

• Each GSA with allocated responsibility must adopt an enforceable demand reduction program within their GSA by **December 31, 2027** and begin implementation by **December 31, 2028**. Failure to do so may result in referral to a dispute resolution process, creation of a management area, or other action by the other GSAs for legal or equitable remedy.
